I am writing you once again regarding International Women's Day (IWD). Unions have been extremely supportive of IWD events throughout the province and we are hoping that this year, we will see the same level of support.

In 2015, International Women's Day Celebrations in St. John's will start on March 8th with our annual Bread and Roses Brunch.

The theme this year is "Security & Safety at Home, at Work, and on the Street". Our keynote speaker is Carol Furlong, President of the Newfoundland and Labrador Association of Public and Private Employees (NAPE). You will also hear from Jenny Wright, Executive Director with the St. John's Status of Women Council and perhaps other awesome women.

The event will take place at the **Holiday Inn** on **Sunday, March 8th.** Doors will open at 11:00 am. This year you will have the opportunity to view and purchase original work by local artisan sisters who will be there to show case their amazing talent. There will also be a 50/50 draw.

Traditionally, many unions and union locals purchase tables each year for this annual sold out event. The cost to reserve your table that seats 9 people is \$250. The individual tickets are \$25. The continued participation and contribution of unions have made the **IWD Brunch** an overwhelming success. This event supports the work of the St. John's Women's Centre that offers valuable programs and services to our sisters in the community year round.

It would be great if your Union could purchase a table at the Brunch or even make a straight-forward donation. If you don't intend on using all your table seats, we encourage you to donate back your unused tickets for low-income women to attend. The Women's Centre will distribute the ticket on your behalf.
