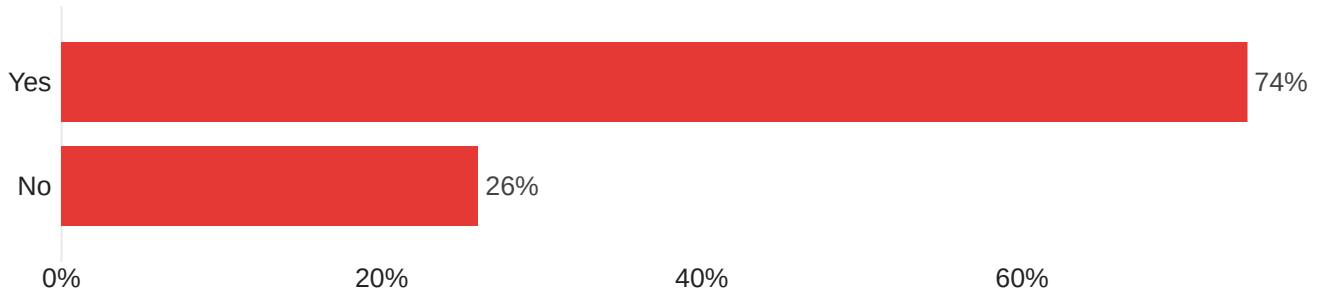

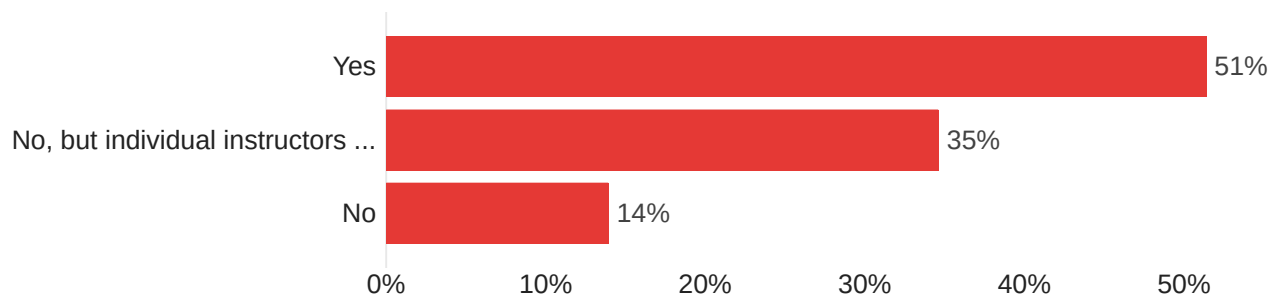

Q2 - Do you believe Memorial University should delay the return to in-person teaching until February 28, 2022, the first day following midterm break?

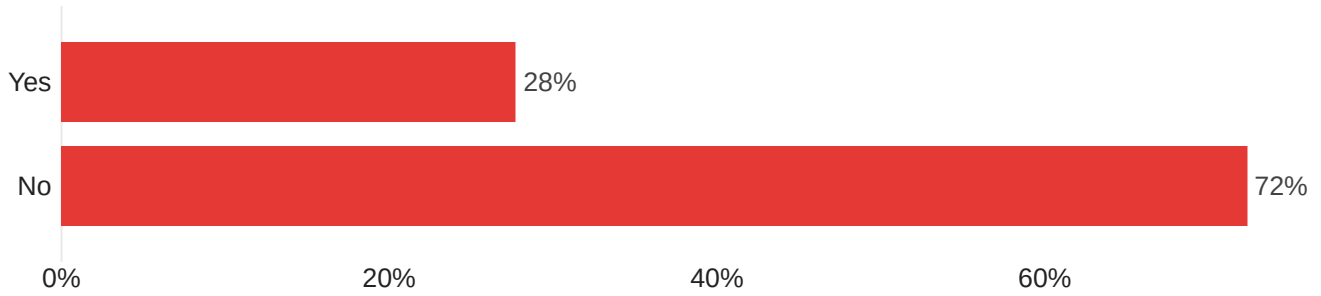

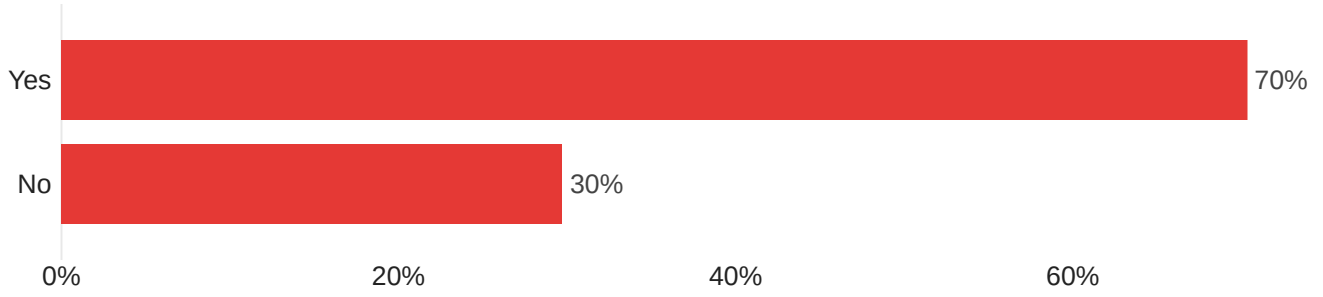

### Q4 - Are you currently delivering a course which will be returning to in-person delivery as of January 31, 2022?

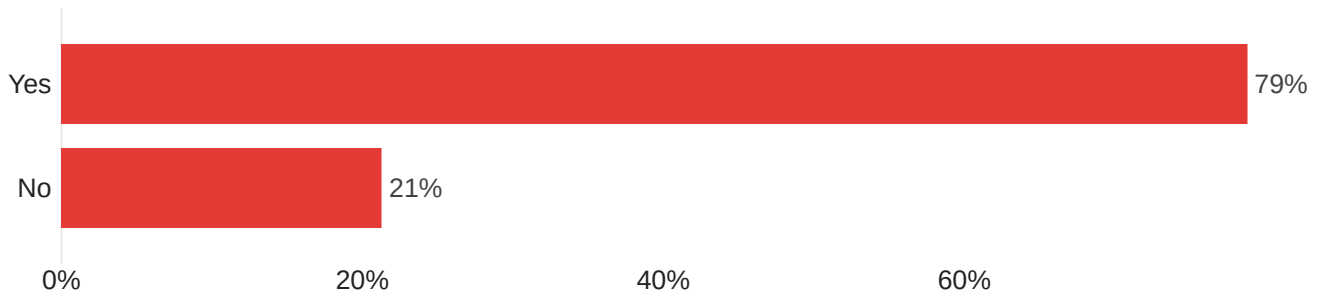
