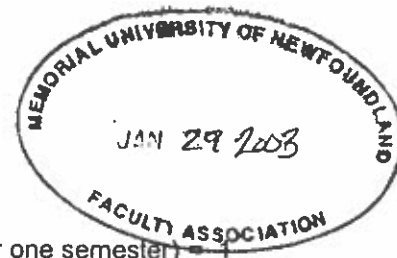


School of Nursing Course Equivalences



On-site Theory course (3 hours teaching per week and 2 office hours per week over one semester) = 1 teaching weight

Laboratory commitment to provide 2 hours per week on-site laboratory supervision of students in labs = .5 teaching weight

Tutorial Teaching

For 1 group of students guiding learning 2 hours per week = .5 teaching weight

For each additional group of students (repeat tutorial) = .25 teaching weight (amendment agreed to by faculty in 2000-2001)

Clinical Teaching:

teaching of 1 group of students for 4 hours per week in one semester = .75 teaching weight

teaching of 1 group of students for 8 hours per week in one semester = 1.5 teaching weights

teaching of 1 group of students for 12 hours per week in one semester = 2.0 teaching weights

If required to guide students in home visits after hours as part of clinical course = .25 teaching weights

Teaching of 1 group of students in 3 week clinical extended practice = 1.5 teaching weights

Facilitation of group of students in preceptored courses = 2.5 teaching weights

Facilitation of group of students in extended clinical course = 1.5 teaching weights

facilitation of group of students in extended community placement course = .75 teaching weights

Distance Online Courses:

Teaching of a theory course over one semester with up to 50 undergraduate students = 1 teaching weight

Teaching of a theory course with a laboratory like experience with up to 50 undergraduate students = 1.5 teaching weights

Teaching of a focus theory/clinical course with up to 25 undergraduate students = 1.5 teaching weights

Teaching of a theory course over one semester with up to 20 graduate students = 1 teaching weight

Teaching of a theory/lab course over one semester with up to 20 graduate students = 1.5 teaching weights

Note:

These are based on our last review done 3 years ago. We have many permutations and combinations but I have tried to provide the pattern that has been agreed to by faculty to date.
